TRAILER SETUP CHECK

Check your trailer setup

- Trailer sits level behind tow vehicle
- Hitch ball size is correct
- Coupler is fully secured
- Safety chains are attached
- Trailer jack is completely raised

PRE-TRIP WALKAROUND

Walk your trailer before departure every single time for safety.

- Tire Pressure
- Lug Nuts
- Trailer Lights & Turn Signals
- Bow Strap
- Safety Chains
- Break Away Cable
- Transom Straps
- Bimini Top
- Board Racks (if equipped)
- Secure Boat Cover

BOAT LAUNCH STAGING

Prepare your boat before backing down the ramp in a staging area.

- Insert all plugs
- Verify the drive is trimmed appropriately (if applicable)
- Remove transom straps
- Load gear
- Prepare dock lines
- Get passengers ready

BEFORE BACKING DOWN:

Prepare your boat before backing down the ramp in a staging area.

- Make sure you're using the correct launch lane (if applicable)
- Double-check all plugs are installed
- Back down slowly and carefully
